#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

A warm welcome back is extended to all our children and families and to our staff to the 2014 school year. It was great to see so many of the children so happy and eager to return to school after the holidays to see their friends and meet their new teachers. There is always an air of excitement in the school at the beginning of the year. 2014 looks to be an exciting one for the St Bernadette's School Community. The teachers have been meeting since mid January to plan the learning programmes for your children and have some wonderful learning opportunities organised for them....in fact they started planning for 2014 at the end of last year! We are truly blessed to have such a dedicated and hardworking group of teachers at our school.

Staff commenced the school year with 2 days that allowed most of our students to be individually assessed by their class teacher for their mathematical understanding using the 1:1 Maths Assessment Interview tool (MAI). This provided the teachers with valuable information about your child's numeracy skills and a starting point for their learning and mathematical development. Further assessments and observations in Literacy (Reading, Writing, Talking and Listening) will occur for every student over the next few weeks so that a clear profile of each learner is gathered and then responded to with focused planning and teaching. This is called 'assessment for teaching' ....starting where the student is at and taking them forward in their learning with great teaching in a positive learning environment.

Can you remember back to your school days when you were given new books? Do you remember how exciting the look and feel of those fresh new books was? Blank pages on exercise books, nothing written on, just possibilities that this was going to be your best work. We hope that all students, as they gather to commence the new school year, will embrace this new school year with enthusiasm, determination and a positive mind set. Setting high expectations for learners and learning provides students and teachers with goals to achieve and a sense of ongoing success throughout the year.

Parents, you are the first and foremost educators of your children and they look up to you and adopt your attitudes, opinions and values. In light of this, your child's education can be greatly enhanced by your involvement at home, in particular, but also through, involvement in school activities. It is parents' enthusiasm, support and involvement that can inspire children to do their best. If children sense that parents consider their education to be a high priority, they are likely to view it in a positive manner themselves. Positive reinforcement will help children to adopt an enthusiastic attitude towards their learning processes.

On Monday we welcomed the 40 new Kindergarten children to St Bernadette's. This is a huge milestone in their lives and in the lives of their parents. It is not easy to say goodbye and entrust the care of your precious little one to others, but their parents can rest assured our whole community will look after our new students. The Kindergarten learning space has been full of joy and smiles this week......each one is a new blessing to our school.

We also had new students begin in other classes across the school. I extend a very warm welcome to those students and their parents. We are all working together for the best possible learning environment for all of the children at St Bernadette's. # Child Protection – On Line Training (replacing training sessions at school)

A reminder for parents who are required to **'UPDATE'** their child protection and for **'NEW'** parents to the school. The Catholic Education Office has replaced the Child Protection Briefing Session with an online training module for use by volunteers. All parents whose child protection is due to expire are requested access the link below and follow the instructions.

An email is then sent to yourselves and to the school confirming that your child protection is now up to date. For '**new'** parents to the school, the same online method is available to you.

#### Taking Holidays during the school year

Guidelines require parents who are taking their children on holidays for more than one day, during the school week to complete a request for 'Exemption from School Attendance ' Form.

These forms must be completed before taking your holiday. School Principal can only approve up to 100 school days leave. Longer periods need the approval of the Director of Schools, Parramatta and the Catholic Education Commission.

Once these forms have been completed and returned, you will then be issued with a certificate allowing the exemption from school. This certificate needs to be kept with you while on holidays in case you are requested to present it.

## **SCHOOL FEES**

Term 1 school fee accounts will be mailed out by the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) this week and will be due for payment on the 7<sup>th</sup> March 2014. You will be invited to apply for a Flexible Payment Plan (FPP). If interested please follow the instructions given by CEDP carefully and return all documentation to the CEDP by the due date otherwise your application will not make it in time and you may not be notified.

However, if you miss out on an FPP, families are also welcome to call the school and set up a payment plan to suit their budget. Payments may be directly debited from your bank account, Centrelink family payments, set up through Net banking via Bpay, paid at the Post Office or simply paid at the school office using cash, credit card and cheque. Sorry American Express cards are not accepted. You may also make credit card payments over the phone. Large sums of cash sent with your child to school is not advisable.

If you have already contacted the school regarding your 2014 fees, please continue with the arrangement and you will not need to do anything else unless your circumstances change.

If you have had a payment arrangement in 2013 and wish to continue with a similar plan please contact the office by phone, email or letter in order to setup a new arrangement as all arrangements need to be renewed annually.

It is important to know that unless you are paying your fees by the due date you <u>will</u> need to have a formalised arrangement in place.

Just a reminder that the Resource Fee of \$120 is due by the 14<sup>th</sup> February 2014.

#### Gospel in Life

He was quietly spoken. There was a gentleness. That was the first thing I noticed. I could imagine him taking delight in his three children. I could almost hear their laughter. His concern for others was obvious in his manner of speech. I asked him why he was here helping others in distress.

He just smiled and in a very matter-of-fact way related his story. The day of which he spoke must have burned its mark deep into his memory. He had said goodbye to his wife and children and headed off to do a delivery for his business.

A long drive and not without accident. A deep cut and some necessary stitches held him up. But it was good to be heading back home. The flat tyre was also unexpected and added to a day that just wasn't right.

Relief! Home in sight. The end of a very long day. All the furniture is gone from the house! A moving van had been there during the day. But there's his wife. That's odd. She's with a stranger bundling their children into a car.

'It wasn't the initial shock,' he remarked, 'it was the news afterwards'. His wife had found a boyfriend and the law said that she could have the children, along with two thirds of everything he owned - their house, possessions, even his superannuation. He would also have to support his wife and the children from his wages.

He was a strong-minded man and simply held onto his dignity, but the idea that he would have to fight a legal battle just to be able to see his children was too much. He then understood why five men a day suicide in Australia when they are placed in that situation. They simply lose hope. They feel they are just reaching for shadows from a life that is now lost to them. I wondered what Jesus would have said to that man to comfort him.

What would you say? Knowing that Jesus did not accept injustice in his society, he would have had something to say to the lawmakers of his day. I just looked on with admiration at this man as he quietly offered hope and comfort to others in the group who were facing one of life's most destructive challenges - the anxiety of separation from those they love and wish to care for.
