

If you would like to make sweets or slices they will go on our sweets stall and can be brought in by 20/10/2017 or the morning of the fete.


Continental Food Stall: If you can make any dished for this stall please return the form that was sent out last term. Please bring your dish on the morning of the fete.



Gospel in Life

It is very hard to go on loving those who are ungrateful and unresponsive, those who take everything and give back nothing. Once there was a woman who lived in a vinegar bottle. One day a kind magician passed by and heard her complaining, 'It's a shame that I have to live like this. I ought to live in a cottage with a thatched roof and roses growing up the walls'.

The magician took pity on her and granted her wish. She was very pleased but forgot to thank him. A year later he was passing the cottage and heard her complaining, 'It's a shame that I have to live in a small isolated cottage like this. I ought to live in a house, among other houses, with lace curtains on the windows and a brass knocker on the door'.

The magician took pity on her and granted her wish. She was delighted but forgot to thank him. Another year went by. Then one day as he went passed her house he heard her say, 'It's a shame that I have to live among such common people. I ought to live in a great mansion in the country, with a big garden and servants to answer the doorbell'.

A few years went by, and the magician decided to call on her to see how she was doing. She said, 'It's a shame that I'm living alone, I ought to be a duchess, driving my own coach and waited on like a queen'.
