Dear Parents

School commences for Kindergarten children on Thursday 1st February 2018

Once again it is my pleasure to welcome you and your child to St Bernadette's Kindergarten Class for 2018.

On Thursday 1st February please take your child to the Kindergarten classroom at 9:00am. The children will finish classes at 3:00pm and be taken to the top playground to meet you. From Thursday morning onwards your child can line up with the other students in the playground.

After you have dropped your child to the classroom, on Thursday 1st February, we would like to invite parents to attend our 'Tissues and Champagne' morning, which will be held in our Multi Purpose Room directly opposite the Kindergarten classrooms.

This year we have set aside two days, Tuesday 30th January and Wednesday 31st January for Early Years Assessments that are a requirement of the Catholic Education Office. Parents are requested to make their child available at the time selected by you at our Kindergarten Transition Sessions.

Parents are asked to ensure that children bring the following items along to school with them on their first day:

- A painting shirt (eg: old large T-shirt).
- 2 x A4 display folders
- 1 x large box of tissues
- wind up crayons (must be labelled clearly with names)
- coloured pencils
- 2 x pencil grips
- 4 x 21g glue sticks (to be kept at school)
- A pencil case
- 4 x **triangular** lead pencils. (to be kept at school)
- 2 x 100 sheet packets of baby wipes
- A spare set of underwear and shorts in a plastic bag (kept in school bag)
- 1 x set of headphones and small pencil case for storage
- School hat
- Library bag
- A school lunch box and a water bottle

These consumables must be replaced throughout the year as the need arises.

**Please ensure your child's name is on EVERY ITEM including all school clothing, lunch boxes, drink bottles and school bags, etc
NO ERASERS or SHARPENERS are to be used at school.**
