All instruments have been assessed and recorded as school owned assets. New inventory to support our new look 2019 program has been ordered.

The current program is being assessed. This will assist the team to determine how the 2019 program will operate. Captivate will be advertising for Music Teachers to organise and run the 2019 program.

In 2019 Band will have three tiers;

Tier One - Current band member to maintain opportunity to play together and Year 3 and Year 6 students to have access to ongoing tutorials.

Tier Two - All Year 4 and 5 students will participate in a weekly music lesson.

Tier Three - Year 6 students will be encouraged to continue tutorials in preparation for high school.

This term the school staff have been working to update the Parent

Handbook so that it aligns with school procedures, processes and expectations. I encourage all parents to access the Handbook which is available on the school Website. This is the first significant update in a number of years.

Additional changes may occur and these will be communicated and we continue to receive feedback and make alterations.

Technology

At the end of this year we will be retiring around 100 ipads as Apple no longer provides sufficient system updates. This leaves our entire network vulnerable to system attack.

We have budgeted to purchase a range of new devices that will be implemented across the school. We are still investigating the feasibility of implementing a, 'Bring Your Own Device' style program as a long term component of our device offering at St Bernadette's.

Attendance

The school's current attendance rate is 87%. Our target is to achieve 90%. Term 4 is usually a good term for positive school attendance as with the warmer weather student sickness declines.

Again we thank parents and students who have maintained positive attendance throughout 2018. We also thank those parents and students who are working to improve attendance rates.
