Before School Supervision:

Just a few gentle reminders to ensure Term 4 runs smoothly. On Tuesday morning signs displaying school opening times were displayed on various entry gates. As communicated last term by Mr Kapitanow, our school grounds will **open at 8:30am**. Please note that students dropped off at school before this time will be waiting outside the closed school gates unattended and unsupervised.

Therefore;

- 1. Access to the school will not be available to students prior to the designated 8.30am supervision time. Gates will remain locked until this time with no access to parents or students.
- Students enrolled in and attending before and after school care in Oosh, which shares part of the school premises, have separate arrival and supervision arrangements for that facility. They will not be affected.
- 3. School Band members who require access at 8am on Tuesday mornings will be able to enter via the school office.

DROP YOUR BAGS!

Gospel in Life

How would Jesus finish this sentence if he looked at you and said: "Follow me. You'll have treasure in heaven if you go and". The man in this week's Gospel wanted to follow. Maybe Jesus had grabbed his heart or given him hope that things could be much better. But something held him back - wealth. Jesus knew that possessions held the man hostage, and he offered him freedom. But the man couldn't accept it. We all carry 'baggage', something that's slowing us down, keeping us from following Jesus more closely. That's partly because our society breeds attachment to such baggage. For some of us, possessions hold us back. Jesus spends some extra time talking about possessions, because he knows that people with a lot of possessions can easily become possessed by them. Here are a couple of other examples. Our society also breeds attachment to revenge. Don't get mad; get even. But revenge breeds revenge. And people who can't forgive are held hostage by the anger that sears their hearts. Our society breeds attachment to pride as well. Don't show your weakness. Never let them see you sweat. But people who never show weakness are phony, and people who never apologise end up lonely. Jesus wants to help us let go. He offers us strength through prayer and Mass, guidance through the Scriptures and other Christians, forgiveness when we re-attach to our baggage by sinning. So, look honestly at your baggage. What's keeping you from a life of love and service? But don't go away sad. Over time our Saviour will help you drop it all.

What might Jesus tell you to drop if you asked him how you could follow Him more closely?
